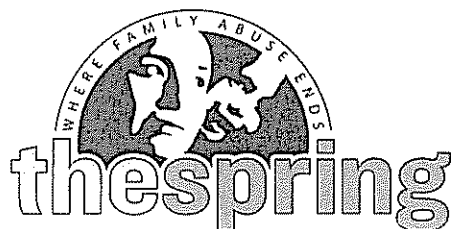


Dear Ms. Rodenbach:
